

Residentials

At Rachel Madocks School we offer a diverse range of residentials to support the different needs of our learners. Residentials allow our school to create experiences that enhance pupils' classroom learning, further providing opportunities to pupils they may not otherwise have.

These experiences have a positive effect for our students in many ways such as through self-esteem and confidence levels, thereby improving their emotional health and wellbeing. We ensure that these trips are highly staff according to the needs of the students and each trip has its own risk assessment which we store on Evolve which is reviewed by our local authority. We offer families a payment plan to support in making trips manageable to pay.

Our residential offers:

KS1/2

To allow students to build themselves towards residentials further from home, we offer the exciting opportunity to have an overnight stay at our school. This is a great way for students to build their resilience, by staying away from home, in a familiar setting that offers our students that safety and security. Students will access a range of activities including swimming in the school pool, campfire/ BBQ's, evening treasure hunts and evening cinema in the hall.



KS3/4 SLD

We offer the opportunity for students to take part in one overnight residential either at Fairthorne or Calshot. Activity centres are rotated most years. Both venues offer a wide range of outdoor activities such as kayaking, cycling, Ringos, jumping pillow, abseiling and climbing. The evenings always finish with songs around the campfire with some marshmallows.

KS4/4 PMLD

Students have the opportunity to spend 5 days in Devon's Calvert Activity Centre in Exmoor, a trip we offer every other year. The activity centre has specialised equipment and accessible facilities to support our students in wheelchairs. Over the course of the five days students are able to take part in activities which include abseiling, horse riding, sailing, cycling and archery.



Post 16

Post 16 welcome a five-day residential to Calshot. Students have the opportunity to take part in a number of activities which include kayaking, rock climbing and archery. Students can take part in evening activities which include a film night, science and construction activities.
