At Rachel Madocks, we offer a wide range of Theme Days to support our pupils when learning specific subjects. We have whole school theme days for Modern Foreign Languages and Religious Education. We also have Humanities linked to theme days across our Primary department. We understand that these subjects can be difficult for our pupils to understand and therefore we make the days fun and exciting to help engage our pupils when learning.

Across the year we have three MFL days, six RE days and six Humanities days. Our theme days offer opportunities for our pupils to come together and learn and reflect on beliefs, values, historical events, religions and different countries.

At the end of each year, we hold our annual Summer Fun Day. We invite all parents and carers to come and enjoy an afternoon of entertainment and activities with their children.







What do our theme days aim to achieve?

- Students are introduced to a variety of Topics which act as a vehicle to learn.
- Students develop an understanding of various events through story telling which may be traditional and/or multisensory
- Students develop communication skills such as questioning and increase their symbol or word knowledge
- Students experience cause and effect and sequencing skills
- Students develop tactile awareness and fine motor skills
- Students develop skills to name and describe events that have happened
